
### Jack Rose

## VERMOUTH & FRIENDS

### Belsazar Rose £8

Created in Baden at the edge of the Black Forest in Germany, with a blend of six wines flavoured with up to twenty spices, herbs, peels, blossoms and small-batch fruit brandy. The blends are then aged in stoneware casks for a number of months in order to preserve aromas and tastes. It has been described as a 'unique development in the field of vermouth' with a 'zesty, fresh and light flavour'.

### Berto £7

Classic Italian vermouth from Piedmonte, sweet and bitter flavours appear on the nose and are elegantly supported by hints of vanilla and citrus. The finesse of this drink presents itself beautifully in an initial soft, alcoholic embrace on the palate with flavours of mandarin, citrus peel, liquorice, white pepper and Christmas spices of cinnamon and nutmeg.

### Byrrh Grand Quiquina £7

Founded in 1873 by Violet's Brothers in the small town of Thuir, South of France. By 1935 Byrrh was the leading brand in French Aperitifs that, after being forgotten, has only recently been rediscovered by connoisseurs and is now making a huge comeback. Naturally sweetened by its Muscat wine base and defined by the finest cinchona bark.

### Cocchi Americano £5.50

Based on a Moscato wine blend with a secret recipe of herbs and spices including gentian, cinchona and orange peels. Complex flavours of elderflower, honey, citrus, baked apple and pear, balanced between sweet and bitter.

### Carpano Antica Formula £7.50

Made from an original recipe by Antonio Benedetto Carpano, the man credited for creating modern vermouth in Turin in 1786. Tobacco, dried prune, chocolate, clove, cinnamon, woods and spices. Full and round.

### La Quintinye Vermouth Royal £5.50

Blend of red Pineau des Chaentes and twenty-eight different botanicals, creating an exciting and quite intense vermouth. Named in honour of Jean-Baptiste de la Quintinye, botanist and gardener to Louis XIV, who was in charge of assembling the fruit, vegetables and most importantly the herbs for the King's banquet.

### Noilly Prat Extra Dry £4.50

Made from Picpoul de Pinet and Clairette wines, matured first in large Canadian oak before smaller Limousin oak. A secret recipe of twenty botanicals is added by hand every day to create the famous Noilly Prat Extra Dry.

### Punt e Mes £4

Literally translates to 'point and a half'. Punt e Mes is darker, richer and slightly more bitter than your ordinary Italian sweet vermouth, it makes a perfect Negroni.

### Sacred Spiced English Vermouth £8

Created by Ian Hart in his micro-distillery in Highgate. Ian uses red wine from Three Choirs, wormwood from Somerset, blended with barks, peels, spices and herbs including organic thyme from the New Forest..

## VERMOUTH & FRIENDS

- Vermouth del Professore Classico** £4  
Born from the collaboration of Chef Federico Ricatto, distiller Carlos Quaglia and bartenders at the Jerry Thomas speakeasy in Rome. A fine balance between the refreshing flavours of herbs and spices, complimented by the bitter sweet notes of ginger and lime peel.
- Vermouth del Professore Rosso** £6  
Quaglia insists that this ensures the intensity and authenticity of the aromas within the vermouth as they oversee the whole process from grape and herbs to the finished product. The vermouth matures for six months in small oak barrels producing complex aromas of balsamic, mint, orange peel and vanilla.
- Aperol** £5  
Bittersweet aperitif made out of sixteen botanicals including gentian, sweet orange, rhubarb and cinchona. Sophisticated balance between sweet citrus and rhubarb with just enough herbaceous bitterness. Sexy!
- Campari** £5  
We can't name any decent bar who wouldn't make space on their shelves for a bottle of Campari. Intense aromas of tree bark, roots, quinine, honey and citrus peels. Perennially attractive taste!
- Clementi Antico Elixir Di China** £8.50  
In 1884, pharmacist Clementi began to produce a curative elixir containing calisaya and succirubra cinchona bark using a secret recipe from South American Indians. Scents of medicinal herbs and fresh citrus are paired with caramel notes.
- Cynar** £5  
Artichoke based aperitif, Cynar infuses thirteen botanicals. First launched, in 1952, as a digestif, its rich flavours of bittersweet balsamic character make it a good substitute for sweet vermouth.
- Fernet Branca** £8  
27 botanicals are used to create the most unappreciated amazing Italian bitter. Deep aromas of peppermint leaf, chicory, cocoa, peppery spice, bitter roots and medicinal herbs. Would you dare?
- Kamm & Sons** £9.50  
Brainchild of Alex Kammerling, made in London, and a great answer to the Italian titans. Ginseng, grapefruit, juniper berries, manuka honey... in fact not less than forty-five botanicals are used to create this elegant English aperitif.
- Montenegro** £7  
Amaro Montenegro was first produced in 1885 in Bologna by a famous Italian spirits manufacturer. The name intended to pay homage to the second Queen of Italy, Princess Helen of Montenegro on the occasion of her marriage.
- Tarquins Cornish Pastis** £8  
Blended with spring water from the North Cornwall coast, this unique Pastis is infused with gorse flowers from the cliff tops nearby with notes of aniseed and citrus and a complex flavour from carefully sourced botanicals. Delicious with mineral water or orange juice.

The Artist blend is rich, fruity and very approachable with a spicy kick. A versatile Scotch with a high malt content, aged in high quality American cask.

Sipsmith has been a west London local since 2009. Copper pot distilled to create smooth uncompromised vodka. The nose, palate and finish give underlying notes of wheat with rich creamy mouth feel and a nutty spiced pepper finish.

Monymusk distillery is Jamaica's has been operating for over two hundred years. Typical waxy banana leaf on the nose, the rum then gives way to enticingly sweet tropical flavours on the palate with a slightly oily body followed by a vibrant oak finish.

### Mezan Trinidad Caroni 1999

The Caroni distillery was established in 1918 and closed in 1993. Tropical fruit, desiccated coconut and light orangey oak on the nose. The palate reveals notes of muscovado and raisin fudge, a light oak structure and good finesse.

### Guyana Diamond Port Mourant 2005

A rum faithful to the old traditions of the British Guyana, meticulously selected and distilled in Port Mourant wooden double still in the Diamond distillery by the Demerara river. A complex rum with pronounced aromas of tropical fruits, toast and eucalyptus, balanced ginger, guava and banana on the palate with an oaky slightly citric finish.

### Hacienda de Chihuahua, Sotol Plata

Made of 100% Dasylirion agave and wild-harvested in the Chihuahua desert of northern Mexico, this wild agave matures for fifteen years before harvest. Amazing complex character. All at once; hearty, vegetal, fresh, crisp and intensely smooth.

### Ocho 'Single Estate' Tequila Anejo

The first makers to demonstrate that terroir exists in agave spirit production. Harvested from 'La Magueyera', reflecting the terroir of the Tequila Valley, it holds a rich palate of red stone fruit, caramel, chocolate, pink pepper, and a rich, vegetal finish.

### Macchu Pisco

Macchu is a single variety distillate made from the Quebranta grape distilled in copper pot stills in the traditional method. Medium to full bodied palate with flavours of pear, sweet cream and pepper. Finishing with a slightly tannic, dry yet fruity note

### Maxime Trijol V.S.O.P Cognac Grande Champagne £5.50

This amazing 'Grande Champagne' is a blend of Cognacs aged between ten and twenty years that gives a well-structured body, mellow and rich, releasing dried prune, fresh apricot, vanilla and a hint of oak, finishing with a little tickle of fire.

### Armagnac Baron de Sigognac 10 Year Old £6

A thirty hectare vineyard with 75% ugni blanc and the rest of baco vines planted on a very fine clay-sand soils, high acidity with elements of iron and rich areas of limestone. Very round and full in the mouth, earthy with notes of dried fruit, toffee, wood and spice, finishing long with hints of almond and vanilla.

### Calvados Dupont V.S.O.P £7

This V.S.O.P is made from a blend of mainly sweet but also bittersweet apples with acidity and aged for a minimum of four years in slightly toasted oak. Complex with fresh fruits note, round and long lasting finishing with dried fruits aromas.

Leyrat Cognac found its roots in the chalky soil of the fins bois receiving more than average sunlight. The vineyard offers perfect terroir to produce a distinct Cognac. This XO blends twenty or so Cognacs aged separately for different lengths of time. Notes of butterscotch, dried leaves and fruits on the palate. The finish is soft buttery caramel with a slight tingle from the beautifully balanced tannins.

### Ragnaud Sabourin Fontvielle No. 35 £16

The Fonteville no 35 takes its name from a plot containing some of the estate's oldest vines. On these are planted 60% ugni blanc, 40% folle blanche and colombard. This blend of three grape varieties, distilled and aged separately, gives the Cognac an exceptional charm. Quintessential grande Champagne; dried fruits, orange rind and blossom combined with rich and oily unctuous notes. Excellent balance with a long complex and well developed finish. Very close to perfection.

### Walnut Wine £8

Created with walnut, wine and eau de vie produced in their domaine. Macerated for thirty-six weeks, the aromas of walnuts are truly sensational. Extremely well balanced with a long fresh finish.
